ORDER

As per the Executive Instructions 2 regarding Ordinary Casual Leave in annexure VII of Appendix I to the Fundamental Rules, Casual Leave may be combined with compensatory leave, Sunday or other authorised holidays provided that the resulting period of absence from duty does not exceed ten days.

2. A point has been raised whether a Government servant who is availing himself of casual leave in combination with Compensatory Leave, Government Holidays, etc, for a period of ten days as per the above instruction may be permitted to avail himself of the holidays which are incidentally declared as holidays on account of natural calamities, death of National Leaders, Religious occasion, (e.g. change in the date of the festival as per the religious head) Bandhs, strikes etc. though the resulting period of their absence exceeds ten days.

3. The Government, after careful consideration, direct that item eleventh and subsequent days, if any, are incidentally declared as holidays on account of any of the reasons referred to in para 2 above, a Government servant who is on Casual Leave, Compensatory Leave etc, may avail himself of those days also even though the period of his absence exceeds ten days.

4. The following amendment is issued to the Fundamental Rules.

AMENDMENT

In the said Fundamental Rules, in Appendix I, in Annexure VII under the heading "Ordinary Casual Leave" in instruction 2, the following sentence shall be added at the end, namely.

"If the eleventh and subsequent days are incidentally declared as holidays on account of natural calamities, death of national leaders, bandhs, strikes, a change in the date of the festival as per the announcements made by religious heads during religious occasions, etc. a Government servant who is on casual leave or compensatory leave may avail himself of those days also even though the period of absence exceeds ten days.
